ANCIENT FAINI MILL

GREZZANO (BORGO SAN LORENZO)

Workshop "LET'S LEARN TO GRIND FLOUR ..."

After a brief visit to the mill, visitors are introduced to the cycle of the production of flour, from the riddling of the grain (riddling room), to the sifting of the flour. By means of a working model visitors will be shown the movement of the old vanes and once the machinery of the grindstones starts to work, visitors will watch grain being ground into flour. They will help to sift wholegrain flour from the millstone to select type 'O' flour and bran.

Visit "AMONG ANCIENT WALLS AND KNIFE-MAKERS"

Visit to discover the history of knife-making from the 15th century to present times and the history of the numerous Vicari who have left us considerable artistic and historical documents (for example the mechanism of the clock of Brunelleschi's tower, Ghirlandaio's fresco, the coats of arms of the Della Robbia school, the fascinating pre-unity archive, and so on)

The art of crafting iron: with a master knife-maker from the town, in the old "Bottega" (workshop), it will be possible to assist and take part in the making of a knife.

Assisted by the expert hands of the artisan one can try to assemble the various pieces that make up a knife.

MUSEUM SYSTEM OF THE MUGELLO AND MONTAGNA FIORENTINA

The Museo Diffuso collects memories and objects which recall those traditional crafts involving the use of natural resources, the world of sharecropping, traces of ancient settlements, religious beliefs, the manufacture of art objects. It has also been thought of as a permanent workshop for the protection and appreciation of the landscape, to secure a system of ongoing maintenance of the territory and to highlight the specific characteristics of the area. The Museo Diffuso today is a system of collaboration between components differing in content but identified as Museums, Workshops and Itineraries: these are organized in Systems: natural, demo-ethno-antropological, artistic heritage and architectural heritage.

The various components are set up as a "network" centrally connected to the Central Coordination Point at Villa Pecori Giraldi in Borgo San Lorenzo, where visitors are informed of the cultural opportunities of the Museo Diffuso and on how to enjoy them.

The museum system involves the municipalities of Borgo San Lorenzo, Dicomano, Firenzuola, Palazzuolo sul Senio, Rufina, Scarperia and Vicchio.
